The High Commissioner for Human Rights in the Russian Federation Tatiana Moskalkova met with Elena Malysheva, a professor of medicine and a public figure, during her visit to the Research Institute of Emergency Pediatric Surgery and Traumatology in Moscow.

During her visit to wounded children who survived the horrors of the neonationalists, the Commissioner saw what miracles the doctors at this institute can accomplish: not a single amputation was performed thanks to the doctors' utmost professionalism, especially despite the complicated multiple limb fractures caused by mine blast trauma.

The meeting included a discussion about the possibility of providing this research institute with Xenon allowing children to recover more quickly and return to everyday life after the stress they have

experienced. Xenon is used not only as a therapeutic drug, but also as an anesthetic.

When people are faced with distress and danger, we must make an even greater effort to aid them.
